



# THE INVESTMENT CLIMATE REFORM FACILITY SUPPORTS ACP DEVELOPMENT FINANCE INSTITUTIONS

The Investment Climate Reform (ICR) Facility provides technical assistance to national and sub-regional development finance institutions (DFIs) in African, Caribbean and Pacific (ACP) countries to become stronger institutions and to identify, prepare and implement projects and investments with high development impact, especially related to women's economic empowerment (WEE) and gender-lens investing (GLI). Since 2020, the ICR Facility has organised a total of 22 events and over 50 DFIs have benefitted from our support.

➔ The ICR Facility can support DFIs in three different ways:

## 1. WE PROVIDE TAILOR-MADE TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE TO SELECTED INSTITUTIONS

The ICR Facility supports DFIs by providing **tailor-made technical assistance, capacity building and advisory**. From 2020 to 2022, we worked in depth with six DFIs. Each bank chooses the topics and forms of assistance based on its strategic priorities. Where possible, activities targeted towards a specific DFI were opened to other banks in order to facilitate knowledge sharing and peer exchange.

## 2. WE ORGANISE KNOWLEDGE SHARING ACTIVITIES

The ICR Facility disseminates good practices and lessons learned, and promotes dialogue and knowledge sharing between regional and national institutions as well as between geographical regions.

## 3. WE PROVIDE DEMAND-BASED TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE ON INVESTMENT CLIMATE REFORM AND POLICY DIALOGUE

DFIs can apply for short-term technical assistance of up to 90 expert days from the ICR Facility on topics related to business environment and investment climate reform, advocacy with policymakers, public-private dialogue formats and improving the existing legal/ institutional frameworks and policies for public-private partnerships. Requests can include for instance:

- Working with policymakers to establish a common understanding of gender issues in finance and alignment of DFIs with national gender strategies;
- Promoting an inclusive and gender-sensitive investment climate e.g. through collaborative gender assessments in DFIs and their commercial bank partners;
- Piloting and promoting new inclusive financing approaches vis-à-vis policymakers;
- Engaging with financial regulators and authorities to discuss potential amendments in the regulations to facilitate financing for women-led SMEs;
- Initiatives to improve sex-disaggregated data availability and define gender-related key performance indicators (KPIs), e.g. in collaboration with national statistics agencies



### TANZANIA AGRICULTURAL DEVELOPMENT BANK (TADB) AGRIBUSINESS FINANCING FOR WOMEN & YOUTH

The ICR Facility supported TADB in developing a gender scheme to offer financial and non-financial support for women and youth in agribusiness. This included:

- Developing a landscape study on agribusiness financing for women/youth
- Drafting a Gender Strategy
- Conceptualising a Gender Scheme

**Workshop** to validate the Gender Scheme & Strategy and expand partnerships and dialogue with stakeholders along the agriculture value chain
